

SHEBOYGAN COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 08 (2006/07)

Re: Establishing Speed Zone on County Roads "EE" and "OK" (Town of Wilson)

** Printed as amended*

WHEREAS, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 349.11, in the interest of safety, the Transportation Committee recommends that to maintain a reasonable and safe speed zone, the present speed zone on a portion of County Roads "EE" and "OK" be reduced as hereinafter specified.

NOW, THEREFORE, the County Board of Supervisors of the County of Sheboygan does ordain as follows:

Section 1. **Changing Speed Zone on County Road "EE"**. The provisions of Section 20.03(m) of the County Code of Ordinances are hereby amended to read as follows (redlining indicates addition, strikeouts indicate deletions; only those portions affected appear):

20.03(m) TOWN OF WILSON

(1) County Road "EE"

~~D. Thirty-five miles per hour from its intersection with County Road "OK" easterly for a distance of 1.23 miles to its intersection with County Road "KK" (South 12th Street).~~

~~E. Forty-five miles per hour from its intersection with County Road "OK" westerly for a distance of 1.2 miles to its intersection with County Road "A."~~

 D. Thirty-five miles per hour from its intersection with County Road "A" easterly for a distance of 2.43 miles to its intersection with County Road "*OK."

Section 2. **Changing Speed Zone on County Road "OK"**. The provisions of Section 20.03(m)(3) of the County Code of Ordinances are rescinded and re-created to read as follows (redlining indicates additions, strikeouts indicate deletions):

(3) County Road "OK" –

 *A. *Thirty-five miles per hour for all vehicles from its interseciton with Washington Avenue in the city of Sheobygan to a point 0.50 mile south of the intesection with County road "EE".*

 B. *Forty-vie miles per hour for all vehicles from a point 0.50 mile south of the intersection with County Road "EE" to is intersection with County Road "V".*

Section 3. **Effective Date.** The herein Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the County Board, approval of the State Highway Commission, publication, and installation of appropriate signage.
