

**SHEBOYGAN COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 14 (2006/07)**

**Re: Increasing Planning Department Administration Fees**

**WHEREAS**, the Sheboygan County Planning and Resources Department has completed a detailed comparison of its fee schedule in the administration of sanitary regulations under Chapter 70, land division regulations under Chapter 71, and the Shoreland and Floodplain regulations of Chapters 72 and 73 to the similar fee schedules of other counties and has determined that Sheboygan County's fees are lower than other comparable counties' fees, and

**WHEREAS**, the time and effort in administering this provision justifies an increase in certain of these fees, and

**WHEREAS**, The last comprehensive fee increase review took place in 2003 with the enactment of Ordinance No. 20 (2003/04), and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 66.0628, the County Board has determined that the proposed fee increase bears a reasonable relationship to the service for which the fee is imposed;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the County Board of Supervisors of the County of Sheboygan does ordain as follows:

Section 1. **Increasing Fees.** (Deletions indicated by strikeouts; additions by redlining.)

A. Sections 70.23(a), (b), and (c) of the Sheboygan County Code of Ordinances are hereby amended as follows:

<b>70.23 (b)</b>	County Sanitary Permits

B. Section 71.13(b) of the Sheboygan County Code is amended as follows:

(b) Certified Survey Maps. The subdivider shall submit to the Commission a fee amounting to ~~One Hundred Fifty~~ Two Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$~~150.00~~\$225.00) prior to receiving Commission approval to assist in defraying the costs of necessary inspections and for review of the map.

Section 2. **Effective Date.** The herein Ordinance shall take effect upon January 1, 2007.
