

SHEBOYGAN COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 11 (2009/10)

Re: **Increasing Certain Fees Related to Law Enforcement Services**

WHEREAS, fees for the provision of certain law enforcement services provided by the Sheriff's Department no longer are adequate to support the services related to the fees, and

WHEREAS, the Law Committee has reviewed the fees for false alarms, Huber Transfer, and Huber maintenance and believes that these fees need to be increased;

NOW, THEREFORE, the County Board of Supervisors of the County of Sheboygan does ordain as follows:

Section 1. **Increasing fee for False Alarms.** Section 38.29(6) of the Sheboygan County Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

- (6) Fees for False Alarms. Alarm owners, including owners of automatic dialing devices shall be charged a fee for each false alarm that is received by the Sheriff's Department, in accordance with the following calendar year schedule:
- (a) First two false alarms..... no charge
 - (b) Third thru ninth false alarms ~~\$50.00~~ **\$100.00** each
 - (c) Ten false alarms..... disconnection

Fees must be paid within thirty (30) days of the date of written notification from the Sheriff's Department.

The fee schedule becomes effective ninety (90) days after new installations.

Section 2. **Increasing Cost of Maintenance for Huber Privileges.** Section 52.03(1) and (5) of the Sheboygan County Code of Ordinances are hereby amended as follows:

- 52.03 (1) For a person confined to the Sheboygan County Jail and who was given "Huber" privileges pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 303.08 or work-release privileges pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 973.09(4), the sum of ~~Eighteen~~ **Twenty** Dollars (~~\$18.00~~**20.00**) per day, together with a processing fee of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each period of confinement.
- (5) For a person confined to the Sheboygan County Jail with "Huber" privileges pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 303.08 or work-release privileges pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 973.09(4) as a result of result of a transfer to Sheboygan County from another jurisdiction, a one-time transfer fee of ~~Fifty~~ **One Hundred** Dollars (~~\$50.00~~**100.00**) per prisoner transfer, plus the other fees set forth in Subsection (1), above.

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Section 3. **Effective Date**. The herein Ordinance shall take effect upon enactment and publication.
