PROGRAM OUTCOME MEASURES

YEAR: 2007

1. Less than 2% of PACE clients will be admitted to Winnebago Mental Health Institute (WMHI) in the last year.

1.0% of clients admitted to WMHI.

2. Less than 20% of PACE clients will be admitted to the inpatient behavioral health unit of Aurora Sheboygan Memorial Medical Center (ASMMC)) in the last year.

13.8% of clients admitted to the ASMMC inpatient behavioral health unit

3. *At least* 30% of all PACE client admissions to the inpatient behavioral health unit of ASMMC will be initiated by PACE case managers.

40% of clients with admissions to the ASMMC behavioral health unit were case manager initiated.

4. *At least* 90% of PACE clients will live in a setting *other than* a group home for the *majority* of the year (i.e., The Abode; Crisis Center; Our Place).

92.6% of clients living in settings *other than* group homes for the majority of the year.

5. *At least* 80% of all PACE clients will be involved in *constructive activity* that is *personally meaningful* for them for the *majority* of the year (e.g., employment; volunteering; structured individual/group involvement/activity; Drop In Center participation; child rearing; etc.).
