### **Wait List Information**

The Sheboygan County Health and Human Services Department has wait list policies and procedures for the following programs/services:

- Kinship Care – Division of Social Services
- Children's Integrated Service Project – Division of Social Services
- Community Support Program (PACE) – Division of Community Programs and Elderly Services
- Long Term Support/Family Care – Division of Community Programs and Elderly Services
- Family Support – Division Community Programs and Elderly Services
- Sheltered Work – Division Community Programs and Elderly Services
- Day Services – Division Community Programs and Elderly Services

### **Wait List Status**

- Kinship Care has 4 children on the wait list as of June 1, 2008.
- The Children's Integrated Service Project has a wait list of 7 children as of June 1, 2008.
- The Community Support Program (PACE) has a pending CSP Enrollment (wait list) of 6 individuals as of June 9 2008.
- The Therapeutic Activity and Service Coordination (TASC) Program has a wait list of 4 individuals with a mental illness as of May 31, 2008.
- There are 101 individuals who are frail elderly on the wait list for Family Care in Sheboygan County as of June 13, 2008. There are also 30 individuals with a physical disability and 73 individuals with a developmental disability. Family Care becomes an entitlement in February of 2010. At that time there will no longer be a wait list.
- Work related programs has a wait list of 16 individuals with a developmental disability, 14 with a mental illness diagnosis, and 1 person with a physical disability, as of June 1, 2008.

- The wait list for day services programming is 3 individuals with a developmental disability, as of June 1, 2008.
- The Special Needs Day Program has a wait list of 5 individuals with a developmental disability, as of June 1, 2008.  
It should be noted that individuals on the wait list for individuals with developmental disabilities or for work related or day services may be receiving some limited services but are on the wait list for more hours of service or additional services.
- The Family Support Program has a wait list of five as of May 19, 2008.
- The wait list for outpatient mental health or substance abuse treatment is 25 individuals as of June 13, 2008.

**A Wait List cannot be used for:**

- Crisis Intervention for the following target groups: mental illness, substance abuse, child protective services and juvenile justice.
- Inpatient Hospitalization for the following target groups: mental illness, developmental disability and substance abuse.
- Hospitalization Detoxification for the substance abuse target group.
