By going to www.511wi.gov, you can get all the traveler information available through 511, and more.

Pre-registering your phone or cell phone at www.511wi.gov allows you to personalize your trip information under "MY PROFILES."

Up to five routes can be set up in advance (e.g. between home and work, home and downtown, etc.). Once you have registered, the system will recognize you through Caller ID, helping speed access to your profiles.

Using www.511wi.gov, you can register your cell phone number to receive a text message with road condition and incident information for your five most frequently traveled routes. You can also use your Web-enabled mobile device to access traveler information from the Web site.

Hearing- and speech-impaired persons can use the entire system through the Wisconsin Relay Service by DIALING 711, and asking the operator to dial the alternate number (866) 511-WISC (9472).

Never use 511 when driving!

- When using 511, speak clearly and minimize any background noise, including radios and open windows.
- For road information, you will be asked to provide a highway number and direction of travel as well as an exit, mile marker, city or county to help the

system provide you with information along your route.

- For personalized trip information from your established profiles, say "MY PROFILES."
- If you need to report an emergency, **DIAL 911.**



511: Traveler information at your fingertips!

By DIALING 511 on your telephone or cell phone you can access traveler information on major Wisconsin highways. Information covers:

- » Incident reports
- » Lane closures
- » Work zones
- » Winter road conditions
- » Roadside services, such as rest areas or Travel Information Centers

511 is available 24/7/365.

Features of Wisconsin 511

- The service is free for land-line users.
- Normal airtime charges apply for cell phone users.
- The system is voice or keypad activated. You can request information by **SAYING:**

TRAFFIC AND ROADS or pressing ①

PUBLIC TRANSIT or pressing ②

ROADSIDE SERVICES or pressing ③

OTHER SERVICES or pressing ④

OTHER STATES or pressing ⑤

MY PROFILES or pressing ⑥

Tips for successfully using Wisconsin 511

➔ Never use 511 when driving!

Have someone else in the car dial in, dial in before you begin your journey, or pull off the highway, park in a safe place, and then dial in. When driving, your focus should be on *driving*.

- After **DIALING 511**, you will hear a welcome message; then you will be asked if you want information about traffic and roads, public transit, roadside services, other services, or other states.
- When making your choice, speak clearly and minimize any background noise, including radios and open windows.
- You can navigate through the system using speech only, touch tone only, or a combination of both. For example, you can request information about I-94 by saying: "I-94" or by entering 94# on your keypad. The system will ask you your direction of travel and then ask you for an exit, mile marker, city or county on that road. It will then tell you what road conditions are, whether there are lane restrictions ahead, or if there are any incidents (like crashes) between your current location and your destination that may affect your travel.

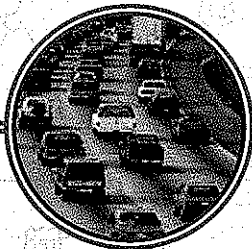

- You may interrupt the 511 voice prompts at any time if you know your selection.
 - » Say "HELP" for detailed instructions.
 - » Say "MAIN MENU" to start over
 - » Say "NEXT," "PREVIOUS," "STOP" or "REPEAT" while listening to traffic reports.
 - » Say "FEEDBACK" to give recommendations for system improvements or feedback about the system.
 - » Say "MY PROFILES" for personalized trip information created at www.511wi.gov.
 - » Say "OTHER STATES" to transfer to Wisconsin's neighboring states.
- To reach the system from out of state or if your phone provider does not recognize 511, **DIAL TOLL FREE 866-511-WISC (9472)**.
- If you need to report an emergency, **DIAL 911.** ➔
