

**NONMOTORIZED TRANSPORTATION PILOT PROGRAM
PHASE 2 Data Collection, Level 1**

Project Name - Project # 13 Eastern Avenue Sidewalks, City of Plymouth

Type of Project - Infrastructure

Scope - Roughly 1,200 feet of sidewalk

Location - Sidewalks along both sides of Eastern Avenue, the north side of Plaza Lane to Carr Road, the south side from Pleasant View Road running east 2000 feet to the city limits/Dairy Queen.

Design - Sidewalks will be ADA compliant and accessible.

Project Cost - Approximately \$48,521.50

Project Purpose - The project will improve network connectivity between neighborhoods, schools and commercial centers. The sidewalks will close gaps in existing sidewalk network, offer the opportunity for mode shift, and compliments the existing nonmotorized network.

Estimated Level of Use Including Target Audience - The population within one mile of the project is roughly 2,753. This corridor is also a major thoroughfare for 886 Plymouth High School students.

Period of Performance and Timeline - Installed Spring 2008.

New or Continuation - New.

Leveraging Of NTPP and Other Revenue Sources

The road construction is being funded jointly between Plymouth, Sheboygan County, and the State of Wisconsin. In addition to the sidewalks, the project is adding street lighting, and future plans for traffic signals that will include pedestrian crossing signals. The project is proposed as part of a larger reconstruction of Eastern Avenue in conjunction with WisDOT.

Will this project include Level 2 and 3 data collection - Yes.
