

NONMOTORIZEDTRANSPORTATION PILOT PROGRAM
PHASE 2 Data Collection, Level 1

Project Name - Project #28 Highland Avenue sidewalks

Type of Project - Infrastructure

Scope - Project provides approximately 1,178 feet of sidewalk.

Location - Highland Avenue (CTH E) on the east side of the roadway from Valley Road to Larkspur Lane and on the west side of the roadway from Valley Road to Hummingbird Lane.

Design - Install 5 foot wide sidewalks that are ADA compliant. A flashing pedestrian crossing signal at the intersection of Hummingbird Lane and Highland Avenue is also included in the project scope.

Project Cost - Approximately \$18,875

Project Purpose - The project fixes a pedestrian gap on the south edge of the City. It provides a safe route for pedestrians from Plymouth Meadow and Eagle Hills subdivisions (125 homes) to the existing city sidewalk system. The intention is to encourage mode shift by providing a safe, convenient, and viable transportation choice that will increase the number of walking trips, rather than driving short distances. The project eliminates school busing to the adjacent neighborhoods by providing a safe route to school.

Estimated Level of Use Including Target Audience - There are roughly 4295 residents, 1438 employees and 1484 students living within a one mile stretch of the project. The project will eliminate the need to bus students from subdivisions to the south and to the west. This route connects the subdivisions to the schools as well as providing access to city parks, the trailhead, playgrounds, churches, and Sheboygan County Fairgrounds.
