

**NONMOTORIZEDTRANSPORTATION PILOT PROGRAM
PHASE 2 Data Collection, Level 1**

Project Name - Project #29 Sunset Drive Paved Shoulders

Type of Project - Infrastructure

Scope - Project provides approximately one mile of paved shoulders along Sunset Drive.

Location - Along Sunset Drive to the terminus as well as along Bruhy Road to CTH C.

Design - Install five foot wide paved shoulders.

Project Cost - Approximately \$217,120

Project Purpose - The project provides a safe route for cyclists to travel from either the Old Plank Road Trail or the City trail system to the north side Industrial Park. It provides a safe connection to one of the largest county employers, Sargento.

Estimated Level of Use Including Target Audience - There are roughly 3,580 residents, 1,416 employees, and 1,279 students within a one mile stretch of the project. Industries located in the north industrial park include Sargento Foods, Plymouth Foam, Emerald Graphics and Plymouth Industries. The paved shoulders provide a safe route for pedestrians and bicyclists and lessen conflict with motor vehicles.
