

**NONMOTORIZED TRANSPORTATION PILOT PROGRAM**  
**PHASE 2 Data Collection, Level 1**

**Project Name** Project #3 Mueller Road Paved Shoulders

**Type of Project** - Infrastructure

**Scope** – Project provides 5' paved shoulders along Mueller Road from STH 42/Calumet Drive to County Highway Y for approximately 2 ½ miles.

**Location** - Mueller Road between STH 42/Calumet Drive and CTH Y in the Town of Sheboygan

**Design** - Pave 5' shoulders on both sides of the roadway.

**Project Cost** - Approximately \$805,640

**Project Purpose** - Located just north of the City of Sheboygan in the Town of Sheboygan, Mueller Road is a narrow, two-lane rural cross section of road that has seen significant residential development over the past decade. The area expects to undergo additional development in the next five to ten years. In addition, the popular Maywood Environmental Center is located on Mueller Road and an elementary school is less than one mile away. Improving road conditions for bicycle/ pedestrian travel will allow for safe and comfortable nonmotorized travel. The goal is to make the roadway more desirable and to change citizens' mode of transportation so more people walk or bike. This roadway provides access to parks, businesses, and residential areas. It also connects to other existing and planned bicycle facilities.

**Estimated Level of Use Including Target Audience** - Within one mile of the project the population is roughly 6,433. Approximately 5700 commuters utilize this road per day as it connects subdivisions, an elementary school, parks including an environmental center, and many businesses.

**Period of Performance and Timeline** – Design Summer 2008, Construction Fall 2008 – Spring 2009
