

**NONMOTORIZED TRANSPORTATION PILOT PROGRAM
PHASE 2 Data Collection, Level 1**

Project Name - Project #43 City of Sheboygan Falls Comprehensive Plan

Type of Project - Infrastructure.

Scope - Project is a city-wide effort.

Location - Project is a city-wide effort.

Design - 5' Bike lanes, 5' sidewalks, 5' paved shoulders, 10' multi-use pathways, road diets and signage

Project Cost - Approximately \$2,641,617

Project Purpose - The project creates an almost complete network of nonmotorized facilities throughout the city. Many of the proposed routes in the project are designed to alleviate hazardous bicycle/pedestrian areas. The project aims to safely and efficiently connect commercial areas, employers, schools, and residential areas.

Estimated Level of Use Including Target Audience - There are roughly 10,680 residents within a one mile stretch of all the projects. Areas with a high concentration of bikers/walkers have been identified that do not have a safe connection with business areas, parks and schools. Project affects the entire population of the City of Sheboygan Falls.

Period of Performance and Timeline - Spring/Summer/Fall 2009

New or Continuation - Project is new.

Leveraging Of NTPP and Other Revenue Sources - An estimated \$50,000 of donated time for the initial engineering went into the project application.
