

**NONMOTORIZEDTRANSPORTATION PILOT PROGRAM
PHASE 2 Data Collection, Level 1**

Project Name - Project #52 Taylor Drive Multi-use Facility

Type of Project - Infrastructure.

Scope - Roughly 3.3 mile multi-use pathway.

Location - Project would run adjacent to Taylor Drive in the City of Sheboygan on City of Sheboygan and County of Sheboygan right-of-way from Kohler Memorial Drive to Crocker Avenue (potentially).

Design - 10'-16' multi-use pathway with the width depending on the surrounding slopes.

Project Cost - Approximately \$6,994,444

Project Purpose - Taylor Drive is a major N/S corridor running on the City of Sheboygan's Westside. County and City staff jointly submitted the project. The facility runs in City and County right-of-way connecting many businesses, large employers, residential areas, and schools. Taylor Drive is currently a good example where the pedestrian and bicyclist were ignored during the original construction. No facilities for either user group are present even though it is a four-lane roadway that maintains high speeds. Two bridges and many retaining walls are necessary to construct this pathway.

Estimated Level of Use Including Target Audience - The Taylor Drive facility would be a major bike/ped asset for Sheboygan County. Roughly twenty-one percent of the County's population lives within one mile of the project area. Roughly 6,000 employees work at roughly eighty employers within one mile of the project area. Roughly ten schools with 2,600 students are within one mile of the project area. This project also links into two existing regional trail systems and will potentially link into a proposed third trail system.

Period of Performance and Timeline - Spring/Fall 2009 & Spring/Fall 2010

New or Continuation - Project is new.

Leveraging Of NTPP and Other Revenue Sources - The City of Sheboygan engineering staff put a great amount of effort into the preliminary cost estimates and design of this facility.
