

**NONMOTORIZEDTRANSPORTATION PILOT PROGRAM  
PHASE 2 Data Collection, Level 1**

**Project Name** - Project #57 Union Pacific Rail Trail Conversion

**Type of Project** - Infrastructure.

**Scope** - Approximately 1.6 Miles of Multi-Use Pathway.

**Location** - Project runs from Pennsylvania Avenue north to Martin Avenue.

**Design** - 10' Multi-Use Pathway.

**Project Cost** - Under negotiation.

**Project Purpose** - The City of Sheboygan has three major north/south corridors running through town. Two of the three are not at all bike/ped friendly. The Union Pacific Rail Trail conversion runs nearly adjacent to the unfriendly Calumet Drive/STH 42 corridor, and will alleviate the lack of bike/ped facilities in the area.

**Estimated Level of Use Including Target Audience** - The trail has the potential for much use. Within one mile of the corridor there is: roughly 41% of the County's population, 14 of the 16 public schools, 10 parochial schools, and roughly 130 employers with over 9,000 employees.

**Period of Performance and Timeline** - Fall 2010 thru Fall 2011

**New or Continuation** - Project is new.

**Leveraging Of NTPP and Other Revenue Sources** - Sale of the excess R.O.W will be utilized to support a maintenance fund.
