

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The Division of Energy contracts with various agencies throughout the state to provide weatherization services. Agencies include community action agencies, housing authorities, tribes, local governments and other non-profit organizations.

The agency for your area, Partners for Community Development, Inc, will determine your home eligibility, evaluate your home to decide what home Weatherization services are needed and provide the appropriate Weatherization services.

SERVICES AVAILABLE

Weatherization services can help you reduce your home heating bills and conserve energy. Your home can be warmer in the winter and cooler in the summer.

The Division of Energy provides basic Weatherization services to eligible households to reduce energy costs and save energy.

If you are eligible for Weatherization services, an energy auditor will look at your home to see what can be done to make it more energy efficient.

Weatherization services differ with each home depending on how it was built and its condition.

Some common Weatherization services are:

- Insulate attic and sidewalls
- Insulate/replace water heater
- Reduce air leakage
- Repair or replace furnace
- Replace refrigerator – based on age
- Health and safety inspection
- Information about maintenance and energy conservation
- Improve air quality with continuous ventilation

ELIGIBILITY

If you received Wisconsin's Home Energy Assistance Program (WHEAP) benefits during the last heating season, you may also be eligible for Weatherization services. (Persons with high heating costs who receive WHEAP benefits are given priority for Weatherization services.)

Regardless of your income, you may also be eligible if **ALL MEMBERS** of your household have received Supplemental Security Income (SSI) or your family received Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF).



Eligibility for Weatherization services is not limited to homeowners. If you are a renter or live in a mobile home, duplex, or apartment building, you may be eligible.

If you go to Economic Support to apply for the Wisconsin's Home Energy Assistance Program (WHEAP) and your gross income for the last three months is equal to or less than the amount shown here for your family size you may receive a one time payment towards your heating bill.

OTHER RESOURCES AVAILABLE

- Over the above income limit but need some help? Call Partners for Community Development, Inc. and ask about the Targeted Home Performance with Energy Star Program.
- Check with your county Department of Social Services about your eligibility for assistance in paying your home heating bills.
- Check with your utility company to see if you are eligible for other energy conservation measures they provide.
