*Town of Greenbush  
Waste Removal and Recycling  
Agreement*

This Agreement entered into by and between Onyx Waste Services Midwest, Inc., a Wisconsin corporation, having its principal offices at 2905 Paine Avenue, Sheboygan, WI 53081 (herein referred to as "Onyx") and the Town of Greenbush, a municipal corporation, located in Sheboygan County, Wisconsin (herein referred to as "Town").

*Agreement*

In consideration of the mutual covenants herein, Onyx and the Town agree as follows:

1. **Services:** Onyx will pick up refuse, bulky items and recyclable material every other week at each residential unit. The Town is divided into two areas. Area "A" receives service one week and Area "B" receives service the following week. Each resident's refuse and recycling is picked up every other week, however, trucks are in the Town every week. Onyx and the Town will mutually agree upon the day of pickup. All items intended for pickup should be placed on the curb by 6:45 a.m. with pickups to begin at 7:00 a.m. **Businesses are not included in this Agreement.**
  
2. **Pickups:** All refuse or garbage must be placed in clear plastic bags. Glass, plastic, aluminum and tin cans must be placed in blue plastic recycling bags. Newspapers, magazines, and cardboard must be tied in bundles or put in paper grocery bags. Bulky items will be picked up at the same time as regular refuse. Bulky items include: furniture, i.e., couches, chairs, TV's, etc., appliances (white goods) i.e., stoves, washers & dryers, water heaters, and humidifiers, and miscellaneous material. Onyx shall not pickup construction debris. Materials not accepted will be cement, tires, batteries, oil, hazardous waste, and any other items covered by Town ordinances. **Freon containing appliances (refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, and dehumidifiers) will be picked up every 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday of the month by appointment ONLY by calling Onyx at 458-6030.**
  
3. **Provisions:**
  - a) Onyx is not responsible to share revenues from the sale of recyclables with the Town.
  - b) Onyx is responsible to dispose, store and treat solid waste that is contaminated or otherwise in a condition that is not recyclable.
  - c) Onyx is required to meet with Town officials or special committees to advise the Town about recycling operations when requested.
  - d) Onyx shall comply with all Town ordinances related to solid waste and recycling collection, disposal, storage, and treatment.
