Recycling Center: W4092 County Road FF (Corner of County FF and Franklin Rd)

Hours of Operation: Saturdays 9:00 am – 3:00 pm (except holiday weekends)

Garbage and recyclables can only be left at the Recycling Center at these times!

Recyclable Materials (Commingled in blue plastic bags):

Aluminum cans, trays and foil; Steel and tin cans

#1 Plastic soda and water beverage bottles

#2 Plastic milk and juice jugs, detergent and fabric softener containers

#3 Plastic (narrow neck containers only) Health and beauty aid products and household cleaners

#4 Plastic containers, such as margarine tubs, frozen dessert cups, 6-pack & 12-pack can and bottle rings

#5 Plastic containers, such as yogurt cups, narrow neck syrup and ketchup bottles

#7 Plastic narrow neck containers

Plastic cat litter containers – 5-gallon size maximum

Glass bottles and jars, emptied and rinsed-out. (No window glass, dinnerware or ceramics)

Paper goods and recyclable paper (Bound with string or twine, or placed in a paper bag):

Newspapers (including inserts); Cardboard (not waxed); Magazines, catalogs and telephone books

Brown paper bags; Shredded paper; Office, computer, notebook and gift wrapping paper

Chipboard boxes, such as cereal, cake and food mix boxes (remove plastic liners from boxes)

Carrier stock, such as soda and beer carrying cases

Junk mail and envelopes (including window envelopes)

Paperback books; Hardcover books with the front and back covers removed

Additional recyclable materials accepted:

Waste oil: Drain oil must be placed in plastic jugs – not in glass!

Fluorescent and compact fluorescent lamps: Bring to the Recycling Center unbroken

Large iron, steel and other metal objects: Bring to the Recycling Center individually and unbagged

Refrigerators, humidifiers and appliances containing Freon gas: \$30.00 fee for each appliance

Furniture, appliances (white goods) and carpeting: \$10.00 fee for each item

Tires – all tires must be removed from rims:

Bicycle and Motorcycle tires - \$5.00 fee for each tire

Tires under 32" in diameter - \$10.00 fee for each tire

Tires equal to or over 32" in diameter - \$20.00 fee for each tire

Materials that must be placed in clear plastic garbage bags:

Plastic grocery bags, plastic film, sheets, tarps and wrapping

Foam or polystyrene materials

Plastic toys

Broken light bulbs

Kitchen, food waste and other nonrecyclable trash

Materials that are not accepted at the Recycling Center:

Stone, cement products and construction materials; Animal waste, dead animals, or parts of dead animals such as hides

Brush, grass clippings, leaves or other yard waste; Hazardous wastes and chemicals

The Town of Herman Recycling Center is for the use of town residents only.

Computer and Electronic Items Accepted :

Computers, Laptops, Keyboards and Mice.

Fax machines and Scanners

Dry cell and Wet cell batteries: Laptop, USP, NiCad, Lithium ion, Metal Ni Hydride.

Cellphones and cellphone batteries.

Telephones and cordless telephone batteries.

Printer ink and toner cartridges.

Microwave ovens.

MP3 players; Digital cameras; GPS navigation systems; Camcorders and accessories.

VCR and DVD players; Satellite TV receivers.

Computer and Electronic Items Accepted for a Fee:

Computer Printers.....\$5.00

Computer Monitors\$10.00

Televisions\$20.00

NOTE: Computer monitors and televisions cannot have cracked or broken screens.
