City of Sheboygan Falls: ADA Accessible Pier, River Park



The City of Sheboygan Falls received a grant for \$10,000 for dredging the Lagoon, located in River Park., adding a handicapped accessible fishing pier and a decorative stone rip rap along the shoreline. The total project is estimated to cost \$176,000.

The uses of the Lagoon include fishing, ice skating, canoeing, model boating, and picnicking. It is also the site of the annual “Free Fishing Days” put on by the County Conservation Clubs.



River Park is a 10-acre community park located in the central part of the city. The park, which is surrounded by the Sheboygan River, offers scenic viewing and many recreation opportunities.

A lagoon in the center of the park is a traditional spot for family fishing and winter ice skating. Two shelter houses, restroom facilities, tennis courts, lighted baseball diamond, grills, and playground equipment.
