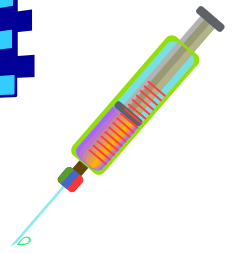


VACCINATIONS ARE AVAILABLE ARE YOU UP-TO-DATE



The Sheboygan County Division of Public Health offers vaccination clinics for those who do not have health insurance that covers the cost of vaccination.

Clinics are held in Sheboygan at the **Health and Human Services Building**,
or
in Plymouth at **Generations** (Inter-Generational Center).

INFANT VACCINES PROVIDED AT PUBLIC HEALTH CLINICS

DTaP, IPV (Polio), Hib, Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, Pneumococcal, MMR,
Chickenpox, and, Rotavirus.

Influenza vaccine is seasonally available.

Parent consent/signature is required for all children under 18 years.

CHILDHOOD VACCINES PROVIDED AT PUBLIC HEALTH CLINICS

DTaP, IPV (Polio), Hib, Hepatitis B, HPV, MMR, Tdap,
Pneumococcal, Chickenpox, and, Meningitis.

Influenza vaccine is seasonally available.

Parent consent/signature is required for all children under 18 years.

ADULT VACCINES PROVIDED AT PUBLIC HEALTH CLINICS

Td (Tetanus), Tdap (Tetanus with Pertussis),
MMR (Measles/Mumps/Rubella), and
Chicken Pox (second dose)
