### **Do you need a copy of your deed for your real estate property?**

Don't be fooled by national service companies who advertise they will provide homeowners with a certified copy of their deed for a fee. Recently, Kenosha County, Wisconsin residents received letters indicating National Deed Service will provide the important certified copies of their deed for a cost of \$59.50 or more.

Fees for a copy of your property deed are governed by Wisconsin State statute 59.43(2)(b) which are \$2.00 for the first page, plus \$1 for each additional page. The certification fee per document copy is \$1.00. The number of pages per deed average one to two pages.

It is an easy process to obtain a copy of a deed from the register of deeds. If you require a copy of your deed, contact the local register of deeds of the county where your property is located for information on how to obtain your copy at a reasonable rate.
